

1. Check-In

2. ISEC work

- Discussed updates on regional meetings and feedback from members
- Discussed how ISEC were feeling and general discussion about feeling disappointed and frustrated by actions of YP UK
- Reflected on attitudes of members in different regions and branches and shared perspective that members want to use the organising momentum built by this movement to help communities, whether or not it is Your Party or otherwise

3. Relationship with UK Party

- YP UK have hosted an alternative vote on their platform for Scottish Members to decide whether or not to run candidates in Holyrood elections in May - also displaying that they could have worked with ISEC to have sent out emails to specific Scottish members in Regions as requested by ISEC
- Discussed this in detail and general feeling that it is undermining vote at conference and should not be engaged with by ISEC members or YPS members that disagree with it - also point of clarification that standing as a YP candidate is entirely unfeasible at this point given that the vote closes on the 27th of March and the deadline to register to stand in the Holyrood elections is the 1st of April
- YP UK have appointed a sortitioned working party to lead on YP Scotland's role within the party, potentially undermining the role and powers of ISEC that was democratically voted for at conference
- Discussed perspectives of YPS members feeling disappointed with structure and behaviour of YP UK and their suggestions that YP Scotland should split with YP UK or set up our own separate political party in Scotland
- Agreed to attempt to seek membership data again from YP UK to continue our work as ISEC and to use a video this time to humanise ourselves to the membership and CEC and increase likelihood of response
- Agreed to record a joint video of ISEC members making a request of CEC to pass over the data, information, and funding that we require to establish an electoral committee for the SEC elections and future Holyrood elections
- Ellie, Fred, Owen, Mathilde, Max, and Frances volunteered to record the video, and Owen and Mathilde agreed to develop the script for the video
- Unanimously agreed to develop an email template that could be distributed to YPS members frustrated by the vote and to send as a copy-and-paste-able document to relevant groups for them to email to CEC Chair Jenn Forbes with ISEC CC'd into thread

4. CEC Proposal (NC)

- NC made a proposal to take to the next CEC meeting that was aimed at developing local and national work in Scotland, including branches.
- Unanimously agreed that this would be helpful

5. Next Steps/Actions

- NC to develop proposal for CEC and take to next CEC meeting
- EG to write template email for members to send to CEC chair Jenn Forbes and CC in ISEC using conference email address
- ISEC to pass on this template to relevant member groups to encourage as many Scottish YP members as possible to send to Jenn to evidence dissatisfaction with unnecessary rehashed vote on elections - ISEC to also promote this on Social media
- Mathilde and OM to write script for social media video and other ISEC members to record themselves reading script to be edited together and posted online with transcript
- ISEC members to await response from CEC to video and receipt of required date and resources to conduct ISEC role
